

What You Need to Know about the Clean Heat Standard in Massachusetts



The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is in the process of implementing what is called a Clean Heat Standard for Massachusetts. This is a very complicated tool used to measure greenhouse gas emissions in order to reduce them. Done correctly, it could be a great way of working towards a cleaner environment in Massachusetts.

As you know, we joined forces with leaders in our industry years ago to bring Bioheat® fuel to our customers. We have continued to work toward higher blends of biofuel, which is the fastest and most cost-effective way to help the Commonwealth meet its goals. Unfortunately, Massachusetts appears set to embrace an "electrify everything" movement instead of a clean heat standard. Here, we discuss the impact that will have on your cost, comfort and choice.

COST

The state would like to see an accelerated conversion to heat pumps and mini-splits. While these have their place and purposes, they are much more expensive to operate than their traditional fossil or renewable liquid fuel system counterparts. As the last year has shown, if your electric rates rise, there is very little you can do to alleviate the pain of those increases. In addition, the state proposal will charge an increasing tax

on all fossil fuels to help pay for a transition to electric space heating. Early estimates show that this tax on heating oil could be in the range of \$.75 to \$1.00 per gallon.

COMFORT

While heat pumps and mini-splits can provide cool comfort in summer and supplemental heat in winter, they are not an effective primary way to heat most homes in the Northeast during the winter. This will impact your comfort if a mini-split is your only heat source and you are unable to heat your home efficiently or effectively.

CHOICE

Finally, and perhaps most importantly, the current electric grid overwhelmingly relies on fossil fuels, which in and of itself does not meet the state's own definition of "clean heat." As currently constructed, the grid is already unable to handle a drastic increase in electric load, which will result in potential blackouts when residents crank up their electric heaters to try to warm their homes. We believe you should have the right to choose the home heating option that will work best for you and your family.

Fight Back Against High Energy Costs

With the cost of everything on the rise, you aren't alone in looking for ways to save on your energy costs this winter.

Here are a few ways to cut back:

- **Turn down.** Save 1% off your heating costs for each degree you lower the setting on your thermostat. A cozy blanket or sweater can make all the difference!
- **Get smart**. With a smart or programmable thermostat, you can pre-set the temperature to rise and lower based on your personal schedule. For example, program it to go down when you leave for work, rise before you come home, and then lower again at bedtime.
- **Seal up.** Address drafts. Around 38% of heat loss in your home comes from cracks in walls, windows and doors.
- **Open up.** Open the curtains on the sunny side of the house to take advantage of the warmth of the sun during the day.

- **Close down**. Invest in insulated curtains and close them when the sun goes down to help minimize heat loss through the glass.
- **Switch out**. Clean or replace your heating system's filters regularly to help your system run efficiently. If it's been over a year, call us to schedule a tune-up.
- **Shut down**. Turn off lights and unnecessary electric devices. To save even more, unplug appliances when not in use, as they continue to draw energy.
- **Upgrade**. If your heating system or hot water heater are outdated, consider new, high-efficiency models.
- **Zone in.** If you have a room that would benefit from supplemental heat, a ductless mini-split may be just the answer. It can take the chill out of a space without requiring that you turn up the heat throughout your entire home.
